The 2024 Curtis/s Family Society Reunion Bethlehem and Woodbury, Connecticut



The 2024 Curtis reunion will be held on Saturday, October 19, at the First Church in Bethlehem in the scenic Litchfield Hills of Connecticut. First Church was established in 1739 with Reverend Joseph Bellamy as the first pastor. In the little town of Bethlehem, Joseph Bellamy established the first Divinity School in the United States. Bethlehem – like almost all towns in Connecticut – began as a farming community, but unlike other Connecticut towns Bethlehem remains an active farming community today – a living reminder of our colonial agricultural heritage. Dinner Saturday night will be at the Painted Pony Restaurant in Bethlehem.

First Church was established when Bethlehem was still a part of Woodbury which was itself established by dissident members of the Church of Stratford, Connecticut, in 1672. Not surprisingly several of the key founders of Woodbury are descendants of Widow Elizabeth Curtiss of Stratford. Her son William Curtiss was one of the four original grantees of Woodbury and her grandsons Israel and Joshua Curtiss were two of the 19 first settlers who signed the Fundamental Articles that established Woodbury. Woodbury – the oldest town in Litchfield County – is a classic quaint New England town of historic homes, churches, and businesses laid out along a beautiful mile-long stretch of Main St. A tour of the John Hurd House – built in 1680 and the oldest house still standing in Woodbury – is being planned as part of the reunion. Sunday brunch in Woodbury at the 1754 House (formerly known as the Curtis House) will be another opportunity to enjoy the rich history of this town and the companionship of your fellow Curtis-Curtiss descendants.

Reunion Talk / Workshop

Member Tom Curtis will be presenting a talk on the *Ten Best Reasons to Learn Your Ancestry and Ten Ways to Help You Do That*. Following his presentation, reunion attendees will have the opportunity to share their own personal experiences in finding their ancestry and their own key learnings. Finally reunion attendees will be given an opportunity to share their most pressing genealogical stonewalls and solicit ideas for tearing down those walls from other attendees.

And a big THANK YOU to Tom and Bonnie Curtis for arranging the reunion and dining venue activities in both Bethlehem and Woodbury.

#### More Reunion Information

As a continuation of the reunion information, the following area travel information and hotel accommodations are provided.

**Travel:** Bethlehem Township is located in central Connecticut. It is 14 miles (30 minutes) northwest of Waterbury, the largest city in the area. Woodbury is 9 miles (15 minutes) south of Bethlehem and 11.5 miles (20 minutes) from Waterbury.

Bradley Intern. Airport is in Hartford, CT, 46 miles (1.5 hour) to the northeast of Waterbury. Airlines serving Bradley are: Air Canada, American, Delta, Frontier, jetBlue, Southwest, Spirit and United.



Transport from airport to Waterbury: Option A—CT Transit Route 30 bus, hourly from Terminal A, \$1-\$4. Two hour trip. See CT Transit website for details. Option B: Taxi-train-bus - about \$50, 1.5 hours total travel. Taxi or Uber/Lyft to Amtrak at Windsor Locks, Amtrak train (coach \$7 senior) to Meriden, bus Route 940 to Waterbury (\$1-\$4), 25 minutes, E. Main St & Phoenix St. Waterbury.

#### Accommodations

I'm sure most folks have their favorite hotel chain. Although there is not a hotel in Bethlehem or Woodbury, there are good choices in the area. In Waterbury are the Courtyard Waterbury Downtown, Hampton Inn and Quality Inn. There is a Wyndham on I-64 in Southbury, south of Woodbury. Check their websites for availability and rates. Don't wait until the last minute as late October ushers in the autumn change of leaves traffic.
